#### Introduction

The NELGA summer school is a central activity of the DAAD scholarship programme in Ghana. It seeks to create an enabling environment for scholarship holders to discuss the progress on their dissertation, take feedback from supervisors as well as participate in lectures on theories and research design, methodological approaches and specific tools in social sciences, while also sharpening communication and presentation skills of the graduate students. The program will prepare scholars and alumni with requisite entrepreneurial skills for job creation and employment. The NELGA Scholarship holders come from different disciplines hence, the summer school stresses on an interdisciplinary approach that brings together knowledge from diverse perspectives.

#### Aims

The goals of the NELGA Summer School is to:

- Provide NELGA scholarship holders with the opportunity to present their dissertation progress (on research design, methods and results);
- Discuss different concepts, theories and epistemological approaches, with supervisors, external experts and researchers;
- Introduce scholars on the art of writing successful research thesis and getting published,
- Prepare scholarship holders for the job market and
- Fostering collaboration and networking among scholars, KNUST, and its partners

#### Format

The 2022 NELGA summer school comprises a variety of activities including:

- Keynote speech
- Lectures by invited guests;
- Oral presentations by scholarship holders on progress of dissertation
- Comments by invited discussants on presentations;
- Workshops covering important elements of research design, and for discussing research projects and results;
